GENERAL INFORMATION

At this time, testing is prioritized for individuals who are sick with symptoms of fever, cough and shortness of breath where they need hospitalization, those who are close contacts of confirmed COVID-19 cases, and individuals who traveled to/from highly affected areas.

If you do not have symptoms, testing is not recommended. Complete this [self-assessment](#) to learn what to do.

3 TYPES OF TESTING SITES

Community-based testing sites - Community-Based Testing Sites are for current NJ residents and members of NJ law enforcement agencies. Effective Sunday, May 3, 2020, exhibiting symptoms is no longer a prerequisite for testing. Priority given to first responders, health care workers & those who are symptomatic or have been exposed.

County testing sites - These sites may be restricted to residents or first responders of a specific county. Some also require an appointment and/or prescription from a healthcare provider.

Private testing sites - To access testing at these sites, you must contact your doctor or healthcare provider.
